It was a day of celebration, cheering, and pizza, one of my favorite memories ever in my long history of watching this wonderful show. And the movie itself, recorded on a VHS tape back in my own apartment, soon became my most watched *Doctor Who* story, especially the first 30 minutes which I played over and over for days, and then watched every morning before going to teach Freshman English. That opening title sequence pumped me up to teach, and as an English major I got a grammarian thrill every time I heard the Master correct Dr. Grace Holloway’s English. The Eighth Doctor kissed *well*, certainly not *good*. Yay, English! Yay, *Doctor Who*! And most of all, yay, Paul McGann as the Doctor! (Not so yay on the kiss at the time, like many Whovians, but I eventually got over it.)



All in all, the Eighth Doctor is sensational. He may only have gotten two TV outings, but these two certainly offered an abundant helping of great quotations. I hope you enjoy perusing them as much as I enjoyed compiling them.
